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WHAT IS LEGO CLUB?

Lego Club is our version of “Lego Therapy,” an evidence-based program that aims to build a child’s social communication skills and confidence through structured collaborative play. At Bridges Speech and Language, we’ve adapted the program slightly, to allow for both structured and unstructured session time. Goals of the Club are focused on empowering children’s communication and social confidence. In Lego Club this is done not by directly teaching “social communication skills,” but rather by providing a safe and supportive environment with peers, that naturally fosters interaction and communication. The speech-language pathologist acts in a supportive role, encouraging the children to take the lead on building and problem solving.



IS MY CHILD A GOOD FIT?

Lego Club is most successful with school-age kids who are able to participate alongside peers in both structured and unstructured activities and play.

THE DETAILS...



Group size

Groups work best when numbers are small...but high enough to run if a child is away or sick. We usually aim for 3-4 kids per group.



Group fit

Groups tend to work best when kids of a similar age are matched together.



Schedule

Groups run once per week for 6 weeks. Each session is one hour in length.



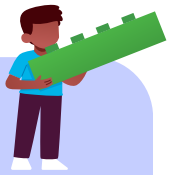
Cost

The fee to attend is \$65 per child, per session. The full 6 weeks will be paid for at time of registration. As with any of our therapy services, the cost can be billed to your insurance plan, if you have coverage for SLP services.

WHAT'S IN A SESSION

Enter and get ready for Lego club!

20 minutes of collaborative building. A new set is built each week.



15 minutes of free play with Lego (individually or with others in the group).



Goodbye until next week!

5 minutes for clean up.

5 minutes of sharing creations with parents.
